- muscle aches and pains worsen, persist for more than 7 days, or clear up and occur again within a few days

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. **Keep out of reach of children.** If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

- adults and children 2 years and over:
 - rub a thick layer on the throat and chest for cough, or rub on sore aching muscles or joints
